Apple Pie

Ingredients

- Dough for double-crust pie
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 1/3 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 6 to 7 cups thinly sliced peeled tart apples
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 large egg white
- Optional: coarse sugar

Directions

- Preheat oven to 375°.
- On a lightly floured surface, roll half of the dough to a 1/8-in.-thick circle; transfer to a 9-in. pie plate.
- In a small bowl, combine sugars, flour and spices.
- In a large bowl, toss apples with lemon juice.
- Add sugar mixture; toss to coat.
- Add filling; dot with butter.
- Roll remaining dough to a 1/8-in.-thick circle. Place over filling. Trim, seal and flute edge. Cut slits in top.
- Beat egg white until foamy; brush over crust. If desired, sprinkle with coarse sugar.
- Cover edge loosely with foil; Bake 25 minutes.
- Remove foil; bake until crust is golden brown and filling is bubbly, 20-25 minutes longer.
- Cool on a wire rack.

BBQ Chicken Sliders

Ingredients

- 1 teaspoon onion powder
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1/8 teaspoon cayenne (optional)
- 2 pounds boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- 1 1/2 cups BBQ sauce, plus more for serving
- 8 slider buns or wheat rolls, sliced in half

Instructions

- In a small bowl, stir together the onion powder, garlic powder, salt, pepper, and cayenne. Season the chicken breasts on all sides with this rub.
- Place the seasoned chicken in a Crockpot and top evenly with 1 cup of BBQ sauce (turn the chicken to coat). Cover and cook on LOW for 2 1/2 – 3 hours.
- Transfer the chicken to a cutting board and let rest 5-10 minutes.
- Use two forks to shred it.
- Return the shredded chicken to the cooker to keep warm and stir in the remaining 1/2 cup BBQ sauce.
- Use a slotted spoon or tongs to add the shredded chicken to slider buns.
- Top with more BBQ sauce, if desired.
