### **Baked Lemon Doughnuts**

These homemade doughnuts will have you living your *zest* life! **Doughnut Ingredients:** 

- 2 cups flour
- 3/4 cup sugar
- · 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 3/4 cup buttermilk
- 2 eggs
- · 2 tablespoons butter, melted
- · 2 teaspoons lemon juice
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 teaspoon lemon zest
- **Topping Ingredients:**
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon lemon zest
- 1/2 cup butter, melted

### Directions:

Heat oven to 350° F.

In a large bowl, whisk together flour, 3/4 cup sugar, baking powder and salt. Add buttermilk, eggs, 2 tablespoons melted butter, lemon juice, vanilla extract and 1 teaspoon lemon zest. Stir until combined.

Pipe batter into doughnut pan. Bake 9 minutes, and cool on wire rack.

In a bowl, combine 1/2 cup sugar with 1 teaspoon lemon zest. Place 1/2 cup melted butter in a separate bowl.

Dip each doughnut facedown in melted butter, then in lemon sugar mixture. Repeat with all doughnuts. *Find more recipes at* Culinary.net.
