#### Honey Mustard-Glazed Crunchy Salmon

A tangy glaze adds a punch of flavor to this fish dinner.

#### Ingredients:

- 3 6-ounce salmon fillets, thawed
- Salt and pepper, to taste
- 1/3 cup honey
- 1/4 cup whole-grain mustard
- · 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 2 tablespoons mayonnaise
- · 2 teaspoons horseradish
- 1 teaspoon smoked paprika
- 3/4 cup panko breadcrumbs
- 2 tablespoons dried parsley
- · 2 tablespoons olive oil

#### **Directions:**

Preheat oven to 400° F.

Place salmon on a baking sheet. Pat each fillet dry and season with salt and pepper.

In a small bowl, combine honey, both mustards, mayonnaise, horseradish and paprika. Mix well.

In a separate bowl, combine

breadcrumbs, parsley and oil. Top each salmon fillet with

1 tablespoon of the honey mustard mixture, spreading the glaze evenly over the fish. Press breadcrumb mixture onto each fillet to make a crunchy topping.

Bake 15 to 17 minutes until fish is cooked through. Drizzle each serving with remaining glaze.
